School starts for students - Tuesday, September 8, 2020 for both In-Person and Remote Learners.

School Hours: 8:20 – 1:35 for both In-Person & Remote Learners.

Attendance and homeroom for both In-Person and Remote Learners will be from 8:20 a.m. to 8:38 a.m. Breakfast for In-Person Learners will be eaten in the classroom & of course at home for Remote Learners.

Student Schedules will be posted to our website and included in student information packets. Lunch times and recess will be included in the Remote Learner schedule.

Students on arriving at school will be directed to report to their classroom. No lockers will be used for now.

Daily Health Screenings -

1. Parents will need to certify through OnCourse Parent Portal their child's wellness status to be able to come to school each day. More information on this process will follow.
2. Staff will visually screen In-Person learners throughout the school day.

Meals

1. Breakfast and Lunch available to all learners In Person or Remote - "Grab-n-Go" limited menu.
2. Remote Learners pick up will be on Thursday of each week. Pick up time to be determined.
3. Menu will be posted.
4. In-Person Learners will eat in the cafeteria maintaining social distancing of 6 feet, masks required unless eating.
5. In-Person Learners' breakfast will be "Grab-n-Go" in cafeteria and then report to their classroom to eat at their desk.

Available for Free, Reduced, Full Pay Status, application must be completed to qualify for free or reduced status.

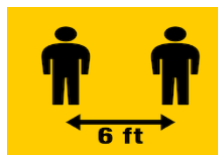
Safety Protocols
